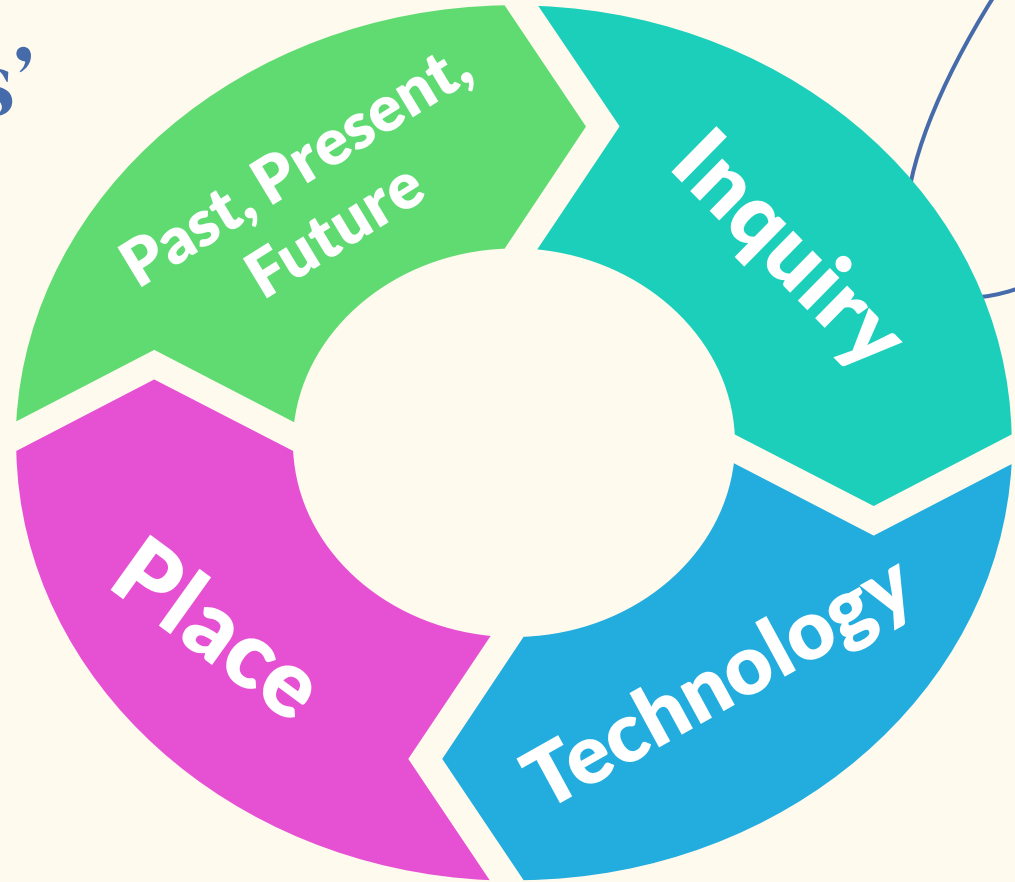
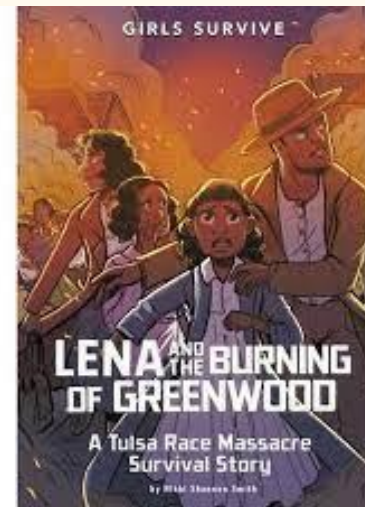
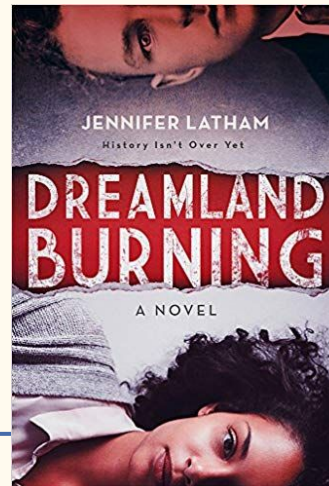
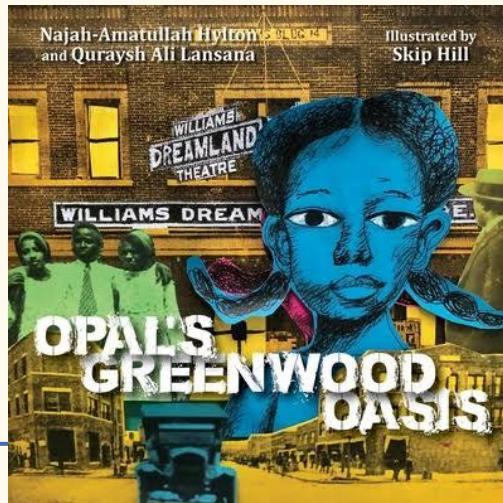
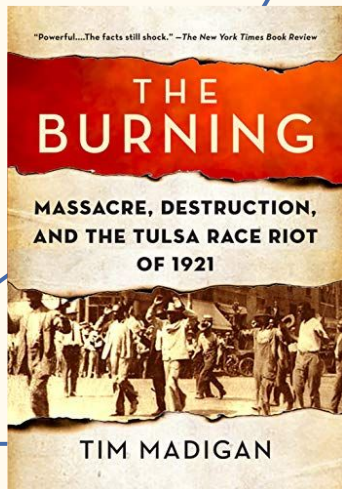
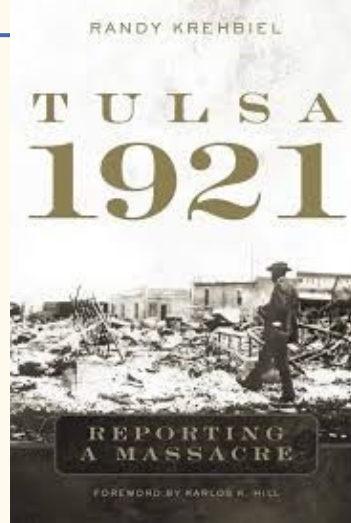
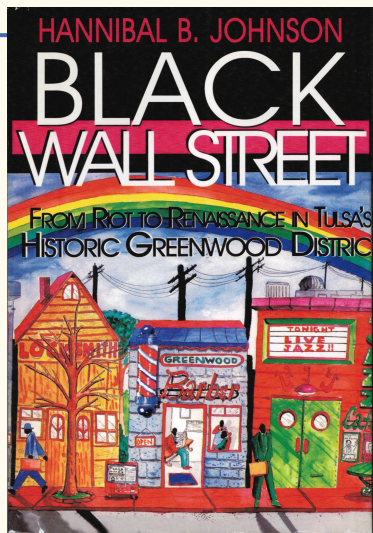
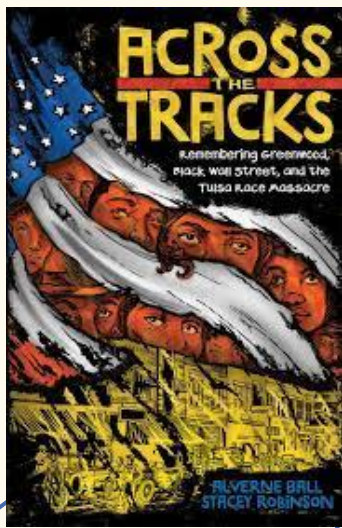

Building Teachers' Knowledge
